



# Inactive Facility Removal

Portsmouth performed a mission of uranium enrichment for national defense and commercial energy production lasting nearly 50 years. As of May 2001, the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) ceased enrichment operations at PORTS. The core Gaseous Diffusion Plant (GDP) facilities are currently being placed in a Cold Shutdown condition until final decontamination and decommissioning.

Additional site missions are anticipated for PORTS; however, many ancillary site facilities built to support the core GDP that were no longer needed have been removed to reduce site risks and surveillance and maintenance costs.



The Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant began removing the first of 16 inactive facilities in February of 2006.
